

Communication to Daycare Staff Regarding Change in CCR Training Service Delivery

Background

In the past CCR has used a Training Calendar to communicate CCR initiated Daycare training opportunities to Early Learning Staff. Currently CCR is revising its Training Model and is no longer using a Training Calendar for its internal or external training events. Instead, CCR will rely upon its Quality Assurance and Program Evaluation measures to identify essential training needs for staff. Using the Quality Assurance process to identify essential training needs provides CCR with a transparent, reliable process to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of staff training, which will maximize meaningful professional development and the quality of service delivery.

Service Change

This has led to a change to our training services offered to Early Learning and Child Care. We will no longer be providing a calendar of pre-determined, CCR initiated, Daycare training workshops, instead, over the next ten months CCR will be working with the Supervisors' Network to help identify and facilitate essential staff training. This training will be communicated to Daycare staff through the Supervisor's Network link on CCR's web portal.

Current Training

Currently, CCR's Inclusion Support Program provides three core trainings to Daycare staff entitled: Inclusion Practices and Principles; Understanding Friends; and Applied Behaviour Analysis. As well, we are currently working in partnership with the Supervisor's Network to host a Mentoring and Leadership Training, the date of which is to be determined.
